CODE OF CONDUCT

All participants with the Scholastic Archery Association, including members, coaches, parents, and/or spectators, must adhere to all rules and policies and are expected to act in a safe, courteous, and respectful manner at all times.

We reserve the right to dismiss and/or terminate membership and/or attendance to Scholastic Archery Association related activities from those who:

- Are unable or unwilling to conform to Scholastic Archery Association's rules and regulations;
- Display actions that are deemed unsafe or inappropriate;
- Display aggressive behavior in any form including physical abuse, verbal abuse, threats, intimidation, harassment, bullying, coercion, and/or conduct which threatens or endangers the health or safety of any person;
- Engagement in unsportsmanlike conduct, which includes, but is not limited to, openly disputing or arguing with any decision by a judge or other official, using obscene or vulgar language that detracts from the ability of a competitor to attain peak performance, even if it is not directed at a particular person. Intentionally disrupting or distracting a competitor in the course of competition, intentionally inaccurate scoring of any round of shooting, taunting of competitors, coaches, officials or others by means of baiting, ridiculing, physical violence, or threatening physical violence;
- Use abusive or vulgar language, make racial, ethnic, or gender-related slurs or derogatory comments;
- Are caught stealing property;
- Are observed vandalizing property.
- Drinking any alcoholic beverage before or during sanctioned events or tournaments;
- Provide false information or records to the program;
- Make unwanted sexual or physical contact with anyone.

Criminal activity or acts or threats of violence will be reported to the proper authorities.

Refunds are not given to any participant who is removed from Scholastic Archery Association at any level for disciplinary reasons of any kind.
